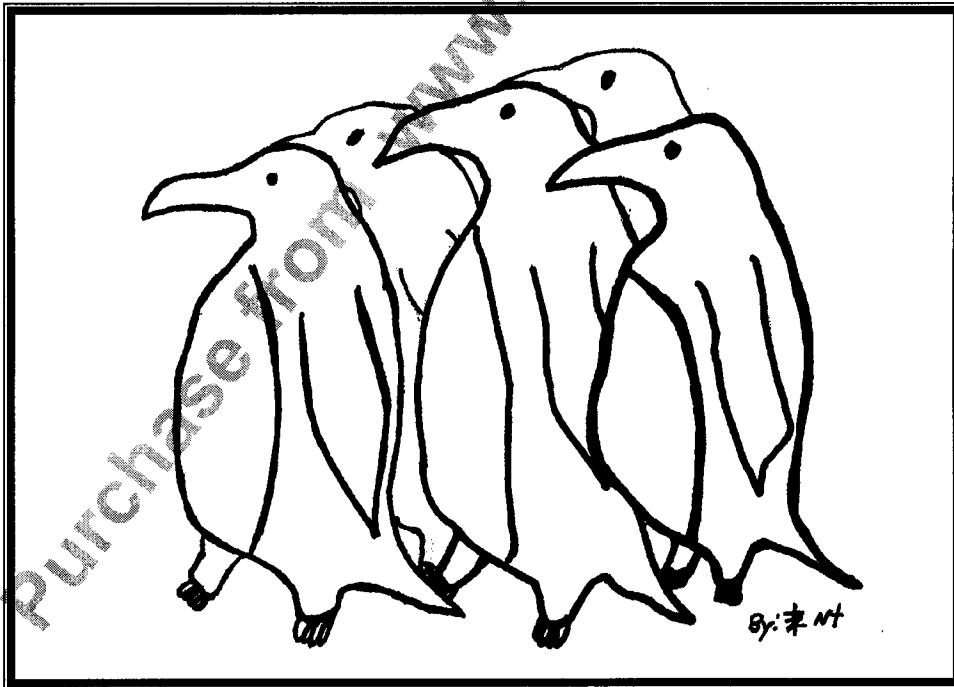
**I wonder if a penguin has closets full of clothes,
